

Graduate Geologist

We have an opening for a full time graduate geologist to work within the geothermal team at our offices in Falmouth, Cornwall. The appointment will initially be for a period of three months from mid-June to mid-September, but this may be extended, depending on circumstances.

The role will involve geological input to both commercial contracts and research projects and will include:

- Providing technical assistance on geothermal feasibility reports
- Desk based data acquisition, analysis and interpretation
- Data analysis and visual representation of data using geology software (e.g. ArcGIS, WellCAD)
- Assistance with field work including thermal conductivity measurements and logging of drill cuttings
- Industry research
- Communication with third parties

Requirements and skills:

- A degree in Geology or a related subject (BSc or MSc)
- Ability to understand and analyse large data sets
- Strong ArcGIS capabilities
- Good knowledge of structural geology
- An understanding of conventional and unconventional geothermal systems
- Good report writing skills
- A basic understanding of Cornish Geology
- A desire to work within “the Energy Transition” sector
- Great communication skills (written and oral)
- Good teamwork
- Own transport
